How Can A Learning Mentor Help?

The Learning Mentor can help children with:

- Making/maintaining healthy friendships
- Understanding/expressing/managing feelings such as anger, worry, loneliness
- Transition; starting at DESS from another school or country, moving to a new year group,

key stage or school

- Confidence/self-esteem
- Break and lunchtimes; a friendly face/someone to chat to

The Learning Mentor can help parents with:

- Offering advice/support with your child’s behavior at home or at school
- Offering advice if your child does not want to attend school or with attendance difficulties
- Supporting parents through times of significant change
- Running ‘Parent Surgeries’ as an opportunity to share experiences
- Providing an impartial link between home and school
- Offering confidential and non-judgmental support



The Learning Mentor will work with referred children

Children will be referred to our Learning Mentor and meetings with that child will either be one-to-one or within small groups.

Children may be met with once, occasionally or on a more regular basis, depending on the needs identified by the Class Teacher or our Learning Support Department.
